Deane Motis introduced our speaker Molly Hancock from FareStart. "For 25 years, FareStart has helped people transform their lives through food-one person, one job and one community at a time-providing real solutions to poverty, homelessness and hunger." Homelessness in King County one year ago showed 11,643 people, with 47% unsheltered. FareStart has programs for Adults and Youths through their culinary and barista programs. They also provided nearly 1 million community and school meals, produced by adult culinary program students, in 2017. In July 2017 they started a New Foodservice Apprenticeship Program to help develop higher skills needed for a greater number of people to advance in the foodservice industry. David Lee started the company because he felt that people in shelters and daycares if fed, could feed the soul.
