Sigurd Jorsalefar Sverre Mack

King Jorsalefar entering Constantinople on a crusade to the Holy Land, 1110 A.D.

Normandy Yngvar Sonnichen

The Normans, an early Scandinavian race which, under their leader, Rollo, in the course of the 10th century, had settled in Newstria, a province in northern France subsequently named Normandy. They brought the Romanesque style of architecture to a state of such perfection that it became a special and distinct type in the realm of art.

The Oath Sverre Mack

Painting represents the new Norway. Inscription is the conclusion of the national hymn, "As our teachers" conflict gave it. Vict'ry at the end. Also we, when time shall crave it, Will its peace defend, "in left corner is King Olaf, the patron saint of Norway, who fought for Christianity and fell in the battle of Stkdestad, July 29th, 1030. The lower inscription reads, "On this land has Olaf painted with his blood, the cross."

Hard Times Sverre Mack

"Hard times we bore that tired us" Bjørnstjerne Bjørnson's national hymn refers to the epoch at the beginning of the 19th century when the freedom of Norway was greatly menaced and brought the nation to the edge of disaster. The stone represents the Constitution Grund loven. The fire in the mountain was an ancient means of calling to arms.

Harald Haarfagre Sverre Mack

King Harald Haarfagre, Fair Haired, 860-933, was the first to unite all Norway into a kingdom. The idea of a united Norway is represented by the two women who supported Harald's wish for unity, Queen Ragnhild, his mother, and Princess Gyda, to which he proposed marriage.

Vinland Yngvar Sonnichen

Figures from the 11th Century when Leif Erickson and his followers were coasting the north eastern shore s of North America.

Saga Yngvar Sonnichen

Translation of upper inscriptions: "But surging the sea tells of great deeds done. And loved is the land as Mother by Son." (Bjørnstjerne Bjørnson). Translation of lower inscription: "Love it, love it, of you thinking Father, Mother dear. And that night of Saga sinking, Dreamful to us here." The submerged ship is true copy of what is known as "The Osenberg Ship", an old Viking ship unearthed in 1906, now on exhibit at Bygdøy near Oslo. The age of this ship is calculated to be from before the year 872 when Herald Haarfagre conquered all Norway.
